



The UW-Madison Language Acquisition and Bilingualism Lab is recruiting families with children who have **language impairments or language learning difficulties** to participate in a research study that examines how children develop their language skills. The study is conducted remotely over Zoom and participants receive a **\$20 gift card to Target, Amazon, or Walmart after each session!**

### Study information:

**Who:** Children ages 5 – 8 who are native English speakers and who have language impairments or language learning difficulties.

**Length of Study:** Two 1 - hour sessions with a speech-language pathologist.

**Location of Study:** We will use Zoom to meet and complete research tasks. We require that children use a working computer with reliable internet connection.

**Children will be asked to:** Complete language and thinking games and standardized assessments.


**Parents will be asked to:** Complete questionnaires about their language experiences and their child's language history and development. For younger children, we may request parents be present to assist with some of the testing.


**Compensation:** Participants will receive a \$20 gift card for each session. We will also provide a brief language assessment report to families at the end of the study.
